

Envelope-Style Pillowcase



Super-Easy and Quick

This pattern makes one queen-size pillowcase.

Fabric Requirements:

1 yard of fabric

Cutting Instructions:

Front panel - Cut one piece 29" x 18"

Back panels - Cut two pieces 20" x 18"

Assembly:

Step 1 - Fold one short edge of back panel down one inch and press. Turn folded edge under $\frac{1}{2}$ inch and press. Stitch along inside folded edge. Repeat for other back panel.

Step 2 - Place one back panel on top of front panel, right sides together, folded edge of back panel to the middle. Pin in place. Place other back panel on top of both pieces, folded edge to middle. Back panels should overlap in center. Pin in place.

Step 3 - Stitch, using a half-inch seam, around all four sides of pillowcase.

Step 4 - You could be done at this point, but I like to zig-zag around edges to give it a more finished look. If you have a serger, you could just serge the edges instead. Sometimes, when I'm feeling extra fancy, I'll do French seams instead of straight stitch + zig-zag.

Step 5 - Turn right side out and enjoy your new pillowcase.
